

TO: RESIDENTS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF TARPON SPRINGS

Re: HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

As you are aware, we are once again in hurricane season. **NOW** is the time to begin making preparations in the event we are notified of a hurricane making landfall in the State of Florida.

If we are notified of an upcoming hurricane event, even if we are not in the direct path of the storm, we may experience some effects from it in our immediate area.

In the event of an upcoming storm, please remove any items from your exterior apartment area which could become flying objects during the storm. You will need to make plans for you and your family should an evacuation order be issued.

If you live in one of the color coded areas as noted below, and your color corresponds to the level of evacuation ordered, you **MUST** evacuate. The following chart is being provided for your reference. The current Evacuation Map for Pinellas County may be found in the attached Hurricane Guide.

Special Needs Registration:

Residents with certain medical conditions can get help during an evacuation. Special needs shelters will open for those requiring MINIMAL medical assistance. Preregistration is strongly recommended. You may do one of the following:
